Beginning Classes	Year One Curriculum
	<p>The first year curriculum consists of three classes, which are typically taught in sequential order: Soul, Space, and Time. It is recommended that new students start with Soul but they can start with Space or Time if logistics of that class are better.</p> <p>Soul: An Introduction to Unseen Reality explores the core teachings of the Kabbalah relating to how the world came to be, the underlying source of energy and language and the parallel realities of physical and spiritual existence. Students open up to a new awareness of the unseen world and the unity of creation in their lives. Instructor: Dr. David Sanders Dr. David Sanders</p> <p>Time: There is no past or future only the present moment. This spiritual teaching about time is illustrated through the Kabbalah's insights into Shabbat (the Sabbath), the counting of each day between Passover and the holiday of Shavuot (Weeks) and deepening awareness that the world is re-created in each moment. Instructor: Dr. David Sanders</p> <p>In Tune with Time: Based on the earliest Kabbalistic teachings, this class provides insights into the different energies of the Jewish year. Living in tune with time means to live in the cycle of the Jewish holidays and the weekly Torah portions. This class is held twice a month. Instructor: Teena Slatkin</p> <p>Cultivating Your Inner Artist: What challenges us and inspires us to express ourselves as artists and human beings? The Tree of Life serves as a map to the creative process. Open to all artists or aspiring artists in all areas of creative expression. Instructors: Julie Geller and Dr. David Sanders</p>

	<p>Inner Transformation consists of three classes: Who Are You? Why Are You? And When Are You? This year long class centers on the study of masks, metaphors and living in the present moment.</p> <p>When Are You? In this class we return to the teachings of living in the present moment and create a personal, spiritual mantra for daily use. Instructor: Dr. David Sanders</p> <p>World Mystics: Explore the wisdom of varied mystical traditions from around the world. Spring semester study includes Nature Based Traditions: Native American, Aboriginal, African and Wiccan. Instructor: Dr. Lorell Frysh</p>

	<p>Messianic Consciousness: In this final semester of the Messiah and Messianic Age, we explore what will change as a result of the spiritual development that ushers in the coming of the Messiah. We focus on the thought of Rabbi Abraham Isaac Kook, the first chief Rabbi of Israel and other teachings from Kabbalah. Instructor: Dr. David Sanders</p> <p>Manifesting Self: The study of metaphors deepens our capacity for spiritual transformation and moves those participants to change in their life which impacts themselves and their relationships. Instructor: Dr. David Sanders</p> <p>Soul of Anatomy: In Kabbalah we are taught that the human body is an analog of God as it states in the creation of human beings, "In the image of God were they created." There are 613 analogs in the Divine structure that parallel the human body. This year long class looks at the correspondences between body and soul and the meaning of the Mitzvot in creating our spiritual connection. Instructor: Dr. David Sanders</p>
